PERFORMER BILLET & ACCOMMODATION

In order to keep accommodation costs for performers (and therefore to the Committee) to a minimum, the Festival utilises home stay billets provided by the local community.

It's a great way for the community to assist in the running of the Festival, meet interesting performers and share your knowledge and love of Beechworth with visitors to the area.

Most artists will arrive on Friday 8th or Saturday morning 9th November and depart on Sunday the 10th November.

You would expect to provide a continental breakfast for them.

In return you would receive a free weekend Celtic Pass for each billet place allocated to you.

Billet placement will be finalised 4 weeks before the Festival. Upon a performer/s being allocated to you, you will be provided their contact details and they will be given yours. From that point any further arrangements, such as access and food requirements will be made between you and the performer. You will need to provide the Committee of any withdrawal of the billet offer or cancellation by the performer as soon as you are aware of it.
